

**IMPORTANT! Please read all instructions before installing.**

Thank you for purchasing a Shakespeare product. Shakespeare works hard to build reliability and durability into all of its products. Before installing, please study the diagram and check parts supplied against those listed.

The 81-S Swivel Mount is a versatile antenna mount made of stainless steel. It's dual swivel action permits easy lowering of the antenna to clear overhead obstructions. The mount is not self-supporting and must be used with a Shakespeare 408-R Standoff Bracket. Standard 1"-14 threads.

**TOOLS REQUIRED:**

- Drill with drill bit for 1/4" wood or sheet metal screws
- Screwdriver

**INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Choose a mounting location as free as possible from obstructions. Using the mount itself as a template, mark the locations for the three mounting holes. Drill 1/4" mounting holes.

1. Attach the mount assembly to the mounting surface using machine screws, lockwashers, and nuts (not supplied). For some types of surfaces, you might need to substitute stainless steel woodscrews or other hardware.
2. Assemble the antenna to the Swivel Mount, being careful not to damage the antenna's cabling, if any.

**IMPORTANT:** If the thickness of the mounting surface is not adequate to support the antenna under expected stress, a wooden back-up pad (not supplied) should be applied underneath the mounting surface during installation.

**\*NOT SUPPLIED.** For some types of mounting surfaces you might need stainless steel wood screws or other hardware
